Welcome to the new production year. Please allow us to crank your thoughts ahead for a moment as we share the up coming season.

If you glance over the order form you will see that we have planed for five rotations this year, a big step from last year. Please put the second order form on your calendar so you will not forget. If you have any questions about the order form or anything please call us.

Several of you have suggested that we have holiday chickens. So we have two rotations right before Independence Day (July 4th) and Labor Day (Sept 1st), for you folks who love to BBQ with family and friends. (ENJOY). For those who want to BBQ on the holidays just add to you order for June 27-28, and for Aug 23-24 rotation.

Gizzards, you like them or you don't. We found that most of you didn't want them, and for us there wasn't enough time to justify the labor to clean them. Some of you folks do like the gizzards, and for you folks who want to clean them yourselves, we will save them for you.

For the new Folks, the on-farm processing is done outside on a concrete pad in the early morning. The scalding and pluckier are mechanical but the slaughtering and eviscerating are done buy hand so we don't tear the intestines. We check to see it is squeaky clean then it goes into a cooling tank were the bird waits for you. In between rotations the sun sterilizes the equipment, and the offal gets composted.

We sincerely appreciate your patronage and your loyalty, and we can't, wait to see you during the year to come.
